What does it mean?

They are a sequence of words or sounds, typically of a repetitive kind, that are difficult to pronounce quickly and correctly, as for example "Red lorry yellow lorry."

Benefits to your child:


They strengthen and stretch the muscles involved in speech.

Your child will get clearer pronunciation, clearer speech patterns.

What to do?

Ask your child to read word by word slowly, then little faster and then more faster.

If they have doubt, let them refer to online dictionary pronunciation

(dictionary.cambridge.org and then click  for the sound).

It helps your child to rectify some of the hardest sounds.
